



Schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2023

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Mount Claremont Primary School Board has endorsed our schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into three sections to allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. Contribution

The total amount of contribution parents/caregivers are being asked to pay is set at \$60 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulation 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments. Your contribution is vital and will be used to supplement school funding for the purchase of resources needed in the provision of the learning program activities. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your voluntary contribution to.

2. Charges for Extra Cost Options

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, activities for 2023 have been included in the table attached (Page 3). Details on charges collected in previous years has helped guide the 2023 estimate of charges. The amounts shown represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2023.

At the beginning of 2023 we are offering the opportunity to pre-pay items 1-4 on your Charges for Extra Cost Options Schedule (Pre-Primary - \$285.00, Year 1 and Year 2 - \$315.00, Year 3 and Year 4 - \$365.00, Year 5 - \$315.00 and Year 6 - \$365.00). As Mount Claremont Primary School encompasses the *Classroom First* strategy, we are trying to streamline processes for classroom teachers. This will also save you the time and worry throughout the year.

Any unused money can be refunded at the end of the year or applied to other activities as itemised on schedule if requested by parents. It is also possible to rollover any unused funds to the next school year and parent's preference will be sought towards the end of the year.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions.
- Specific learning activities are available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, instrumental music program, etc.
- Other activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation, camps, swimming, dance.

3. Items for Personal Use

The list of items for personal use will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons e.g. (Annual Booklist, stationery items, calculator, etc).
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, paper towels etc.
- Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. class photographs, Year 6 leavers' shirts etc.

4. P&C Family Voluntary Payment

Each year the P&C request a contribution from families. This assists with providing improved facilities for the students at Mount Claremont Primary School.
